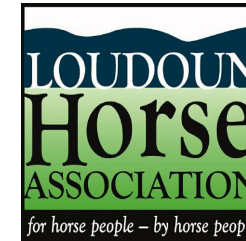
**Lovettsville Community Park Patrol**

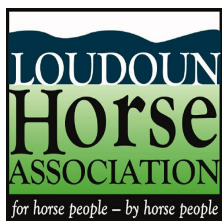

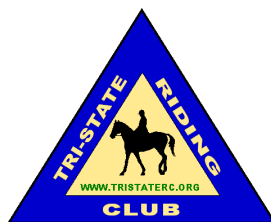
